The meeting was called to order at 9:05 a.m. by Supervisor WurtSmith. The purpose of the meeting was a Class C Liquor License Request from Elk Crossing Café.

Correspondence dated November 24, 2014 to the Briley Township Board from Elk Crossing Café was received requesting a formal letter of support for the available Class C Liquor License to the Elk Crossing Café.

Phil LaMore informed the Board that all paperwork and application fees have been submitted to the Liquor Control Commission and that they have been pursuing a license for over one year. Additional information is that licenses are population based (1500); two Class C liquor licenses were cancelled, leaving one available license. Process is for a letter of support and then formal request to the Board via Resolution for final approval.

Treasurer Valentine-Flynn stated that she believes the liquor license process is incorrect and is not in support of proceeding forward. Revised 12/15/14 by Board action.

Motion by John Zollars for Briley Township to submit a formal letter of support to the Liquor Control Commission for Elk Crossing Café, **second by** Anna Rogers. Motion carried, 4-1 (Valentine-Flynn no).
